- A rental contract—either a lease/sublease signed by a landlord and the student-tenant OR a confirmed third-party reservation agreement (such as Airbnb);
- The rental property may not be a parental address—this includes custodial parents, non-custodial parents, stepparents, and legal guardians;
- The rental period must span the semester for which the off campus budget is requested;
- The student's name must be listed on the lease/sublease as a tenant, even if a parent or guardian is additionally required to secure the contract. For third-party services, the student must be the account holder on the reservation. If the student is not the account holder, the student must submit a signed statement from the account holder, certifying the student's tenancy in the property.
- Each requirement above must be met before an off campus budget request will be considered.
